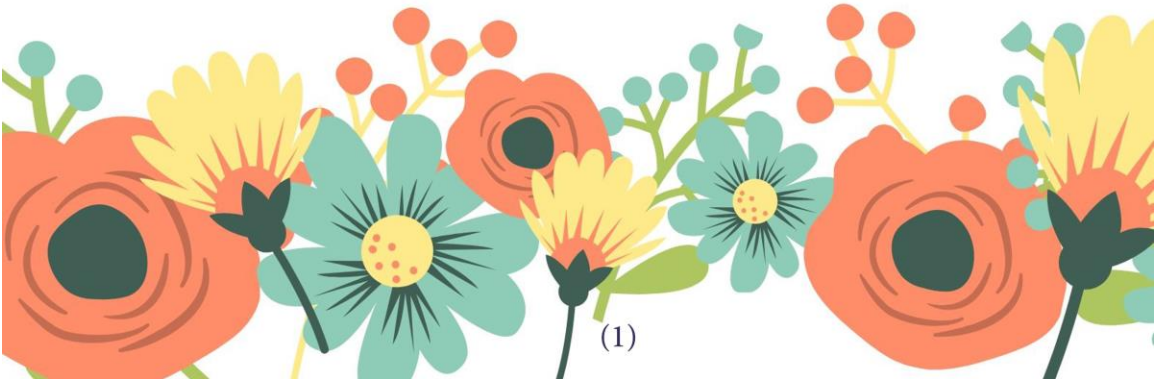

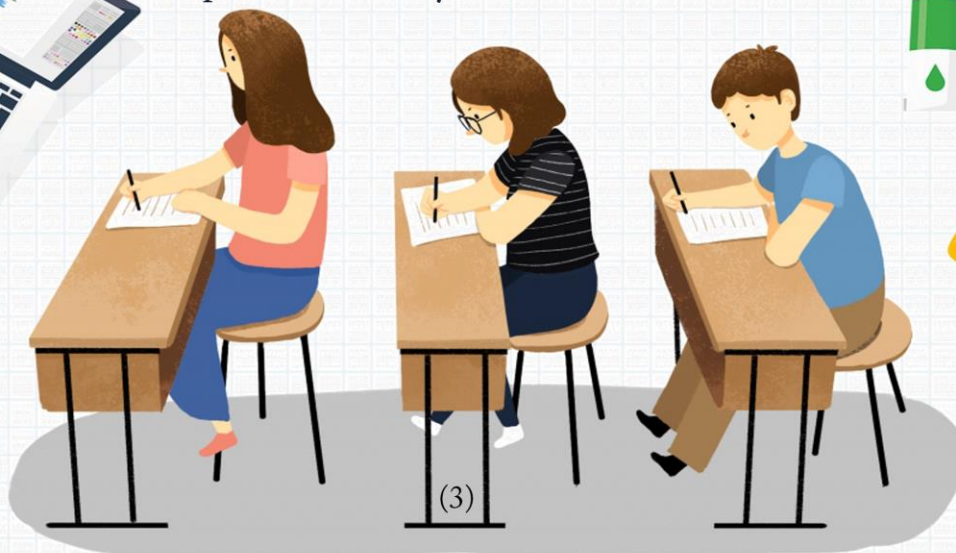

School support project 2021 is one of the important educational project that HSA provide it for children aged 7-10 years old in its center for three days a week, to improve their educational level in their school.

In general, the project target 60 students with difficulty learning low achieving and psychological problems, but in this year we targeted just 30 students because of the emergency situation in Nablus city and follow the health and preventive safety laws .





Work in HSA

HSA paused its work and activities temporarily in March for two weeks, when the lockdown and emergency situation was declared in Nablus city because of covid-19 spread everywhere, but the work of administrative in HSA continued online between the staff, in this period we prepared some of important projects such as project of Ramadan "Nutrition basket" in a cooperation with our French partner "LIFE", we target the families of low income, which contains many different type of food. We hope the situations and the life around the world will be better, and back to continue implement our work and activities in a safe way.





Dabke is a traditional Palestinian dance since ancient times, and is inherited by children from their grandparents.

HSA still continuing to hold traditional dabke trainings for the team by the trainer Tala in its center, to develop their performance and create new movements, but we postponed hold the trainings during the lockdown in Nablus city because of the emergency situation, and we will continue to hold it when the situation will be good.

The dance lesson aim is preserving the Palestinian heritage and sharing it with future generations, teach children how to work in group, discover and developing their talent and skills.
